A program in Michigan that matches SNAP dollars with an equal amount of incentive dollars when you buy fresh fruits and vegetables at participating stores and farmers markets

Provides nutritious, prepared meals to homebound individuals, often seniors and people with disabilities, who are unable to shop or cook for themselves

A food bank serving Southeast Michigan that aims to provide nutritious food and combat hunger through a network of partner agencies, direct service mobile distributions, and various programs

A non-profit organization that connects food-insecure individuals with local, free food resources like food pantries and soup kitchens through a tech-enabled helpline and online directory
